My 18 years at the Nadadores were 4 fold: (1) Dive coach, (2) parent to swimmer Casey Adams Condia (Mother to sweet Lucy May, 21 months. We aren't sure if Lucy will pick swim or dive, but at 110% on the height chart, swimming might choose her!) (3) parent to diver, Sam Adams, Chief of Staff at USC Athletics, and (4) parent to Diver, Delaney Adams, who was often seen coaching the young divers and transferred that energy into her career as a

labor and delivery nurse at St. Joseph Hospital. My favorite memories of my time with the Nadadores were the camps and sleepovers. The late night visitors always gave us a scare, but we were strong and confident and always scared them off. Having 1 child in swimming and 2 in diving was the best of both worlds. I have so much respect for both sports. I saw divers smack off 10 meter and swimmers train daily for 400 IM, and both athletes embodied the "one more time" mentality which contributed to the Nadador standard of greatness. My advice: Many of the friendships and bonds that you form as a Nadador will stay with you for the rest of your life. Remember the great moments and learn from the tough ones. Most of all, enjoy the ride and be proud of your Nadadores heritage! I am now a real estate agent in Laguna Beach and Mission Viejo. With each new adventure, I've incorporated the values, experiences, and skills I developed as a coach. I'll always hold teamwork and perseverance – the qualities of a Nadador – close to my heart.

I retired from coaching in 2000 and now live in Big Bear. My best advice would be to have fun and always do your best.

I dove for a lot of coaches with the Nadadores: Jeff Shaffer, Dave Burgering, Janet Ely and my dad, Rick. During my diving career, I won two NCAA championships, several national titles, a World Cup gold and a World Championships Bronze. My fondest memories are of the travel trips and spending time with friends all over the country and world. Janae and I still spend a lot of time connecting with them today. Because of

that, my advice is to spend time at meets not only with your teammates, but divers from other teams. They can become lifelong friends that share your love of diving. Today, I work in the software sales world.

I mostly married in to the Nadadores. But I did dive for the Nadadores a few summers during college and then after college. My coach was Janet Ely. My best memory is winning the 1st 3m synchro nationals with Amy

Sloan. I was a dive parent for Brooke, serving as the snack bar leader for quite a few years and making team towels. I am currently working part time as an RN in the mother baby unit at Hoag, Newport. Words of wisdom: use diving as a way to get to know other people from other teams and build lasting friendships. It makes for friendly competition. You still want to win but if you don't, its ok too because you are friends first. We have so many friendships around the world through diving and that is what I appreciate the most from my diving years.

Being a 3rd generation diver was truly an amazing experience. It is something I can share with my family and they understand the mental and physical strength it takes to be at this level. 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HATCH CRUSHES PHILIPPINES NATIONAL RECORD!



With only 10 days' notice, Nadador Pro, Jarod Hatch, traveled 7,280 miles and 16 time zones away to compete in the 2023 SEA Games, in New Clark City, Philippines. Hatch brought home 4 golds in 4 events and set a new Philippines national record in the 50 fly, in both the prelims and the finals. Originally planned to be in late February, Hatch was notified of the date change at the last minute but rose to the challenge.

As we know is part of the Nadador way, Jarod handled the challenge as an opportunity, set his mind to a positive approach, planned with Coach Jeff, and got ready to take care of business. This first step was huge in attaining these results. The second piece, that needed to happen way before this news ever came up, was that he set himself up in the best position to handle anything thrown his way by being as CONSISTENT as possible in his process. Consistency + the right mental approach allows you to handle just about anything thrown your way.
