
# THE CONSISTENCY CONCEPT

## **YEZIEL MORALES**

With 2024 marking 10 years since Yeziel kicked off his international swimming career at the Summer Youth Olympics and having represented Puerto Rico at 6 World Championships since then, he made the decision last fall to join the MVN 360° Performance Center and give everything he had to the Olympic journey as a Nadador. Yeziel has been a role model to all Nadadores since joining and has already broken the open TEAM record in the 200 Back, with only more exciting races to come.

"The journey to go to the Olympic Games for me has been a lifelong beautiful pursuit that has shown me the relentlessness needed to get what you want in life. For me, there will be no greater honor than wearing my island colors in the biggest sport celebration on the planet as my family watches me from home - the same place that my dream was born. Training in Mission Viejo has been extra special because it has rejuvenated me in the sport that I thought I had no more years left in. It has been a pleasure and inspiration to come to train every day with world class athletes and coaches."

After growing up in Ohio, becoming a NCAA qualifier in every year of her career as a Bulldog at the University of Georgia (Cognitive Science), and spending a year in Puerto Rico starting her Olympic journey, Portia found her home with the Nadadores one year ago now. She has spent that year hard at work in chasing her dreams, helping to build the 360° Performance Center piece of the Nadadores, and growing as an athlete and person through the process.



"I never expected my Olympic journey to be easy, but nothing could have prepared me for how hard it has actually been. Coming to Mission completely changed my mindset, rekindled my love for my sport and gave me a support system of teammates and coaches like I've never experienced before. I used to think that my reward at the end of my journey would be making the Olympic team, but I've learned that that's not entirely true. I will be so proud to represent my country at the Olympics, not because I made it, but because of who the journey made me."

## **JAIDEN LYNCH**

Arriving in Mission Viejo during Covid, Jaiden Lynch enjoyed the program so much, she and her family moved to Southern California from Atherton. A Senior at Mater Dei High School, she will attend University of Texas in the fall. While competitive on all three events, Jaiden has had great success on the platform, having represented the U.S. at the 2021 and 2023 Jr. Pan American Championships, where she won a Silver Medal. She also qualified for the 2021 Jr. World Champions (the US did not attend due to Covid) and finished 4th at the Futures Cup in Great Britain in 2022.

### THE PURSUIT OF PARIS 2024 IS ON!

March marked the last real prep opportunity for some of our swimmers, as April will be the first opportunity to go for the Olympic standards. Our Nadadores have a number of different pathways they will be following in hopes of being in Paris this summer.

Our US athletes are focused on the US Trials, which is now less than 80 days away. Our Canadian athlete will compete in just over a month at their Trials, while all our other international swimmers will compete at different competitions trying to post the Olympic standard and/or be the top male/female swimmers from their countries in order to qualify for Paris 2024. April starts that series of events with the last of the TYR Pro Series events in San Antonio, TX.

In March, we had a group travel to Westmont, IL to compete at the second stop of the TYR Pro Swim Series, where our athletes continued to represent the Nadadores with pride. With each of our swimmers taking great steps in the process towards the big races coming up, please join us in sending congratulations to Yeziel Morales, Justin Ress, Trenton Julian, Penny Oleksiak, Portia Brown, and Graham Chatoor. And a special shout out to Yeziel Morales who broke the Open Team record in the 200 Back, becoming the fastest Nadador ever in that event.
