Duel in the Pool

Three Nadadores have been selected to participate in USA Swimming v. Swimming Australia. Pros Justin Ress and Trenton Julian will both represent the U.S. in the duel and stay afterwards to compete in the short course meters Australian Nationals. Inbound college freshman, Justina Kozan, will also be representing the U.S. at the duel in the pool. This competition first launched in 2003 and this will be the first version held since 2015.


