We are honored to have hosted this prestigious event and send a hearty thank you to our dive families for your volunteer efforts! 45 divers strong, we set a record as the largest club squad in history to attend a Junior National Championship. We are so proud of all our athletes and recognize our dedicated parents for your support throughout the season. It takes a village and ours is strong.

As a team – the Nadadores won the TEAM title as well as the Women's TEAM title while the boys finished second as a team. This is the second time in three years to bring home the TEAM title!

360° PERFORMANCE CENTER

SUMMER SEASON ENDS WITH A BANG!

The 360° Performance Center Nadadores finished the season at a trio of meets, the first one being the World Aquatics - World Aquatics Championships in Fukuoka, Japan. <u>JUSTIN RESS</u> came up big once again for TEAMUSA, earning the silver medal in the 50 Back and helping the Men's 4x100 Free Relay earn a Bronze medal as a member of the prelim relay.

JAROD HATCH attended his first ever World Championships and stepped up on swimming's second biggest stage to break the Philippine's National Record in the 100 Butterfly.

The TYR Pro Championships was held in Irvine, CA and produced more exciting results for our Nadadores. National Teamer TRENTON JULIAN jumped right back into training following Nationals in June and used this as a training meet, but still managed to work his racing process to come away with a victory in the 200 Fly on the last day of the meet.

Also grabbing 4th in the 200 IM and 5th in the 100 Fly. ALICIA WILSON finished off the summer with the Nadadores before heading to the University of Texas for her Masters and earned a 2nd place finish in the 200 IM (breaking the team record in the process) and a fourth-place finish in the 200 Back. PORTIA DEL RIO BROWN had a huge finals swim in the 400 IM, taking 9th with a lifetime best in the process. The final meet on the end was Futures in Sacramento and was highlighted by DANICA ADAMS coming through with 2 lifetime bests, the 800 Free being from 10 years ago and the 200 Back being four years old.

Congratulations to all of our Nadadores on some great steps in the process, and here's to taking new ones as we head into the future!

We are pleased to announce that the 2024 USMS Summer National Championship will be held August 21–25, 2024, at Marguerite Aquatics Complex.

Mission Viejo has hosted five USMS national championships, including the 2013 and 2019 Summer Nationals. Those were the two highest-attended Summer Nationals in USMS history, drawing nearly 2,800 entries combined.

"Mission Viejo has a long association with national- and Olympic-level sports," says Mission Viejo Mayor Brian Goodell, who is also an Olympian and Mission Viejo Nadadores member.
