TURNING LOSS INTO LIGHT IN THE LAVA FIELDS

The Ironman World Championships in Kona, Hawaii on October 14, 2023, was Lisa Delong's 8th Ironman race, and the one she had dreamed of qualifying for and racing in for many years.

Her qualification came in 2022 at IM Chattanooga, the most memorable of her races. That event, which was her return to triathlon, was special because she did it as a fundraiser for her foundation, the Carly Faye Foundation, which she started when her daughter passed away from leukemia at the age of 15. The race in Chattanooga took place on the 5-year anniversary of Carly's passing and

The event in Kona was an amazing experience being the first women's only Ironman. The beautiful ocean swim went well but the bike ride was the most
