# **JUSTIN RESS**

Justin Ress is an elite American swimmer who has made a name for himself at NC State, as part of the Cali Condors of the International Swim League, and as a member of the Mission Viejo Nadadores. Hailing from North Carolina, Ress has been a standout athlete throughout his career. At NC State, he was a crucial member of the swimming team, consistently delivering impressive performances in various events, leading to 3 National Championships and 21 All American titles. Ress has continued taking new steps in his career since being the first swimmer to move into the Mission



Viejo Nadadores 360 Performance Center in Feb of 2022, becoming World Champion in both the 50 Back and 4x100 Free Relay's.

"If I am being honest, the Olympic Trials has never been my favorite meet with the combination of it being more about the individual and the pressure that comes from such an elusive opportunity. But as I have grown as an athlete and person, I'm excited to compete this year on behalf of my family in North Carolina and my new Mission Viejo Nadadores family. I now see this as just the first step of a team approach, and I know what I can do in team environments."

# **GRAYSON CAMPBELL**

Grayson joined the Nadadores in August of 2023, after attending and competing for the University of Texas at Austin from 2016 to 2021. Grayson was a part of 2 National Championship winning teams (2017, 2018) while Individually earning 5 First Team All-America honors in his time at Texas. Prior to attending UT, he competed for Dominion Dive Club where he won 13 Junior National titles. A finalist in the Men's 3m Springboard at the 2016 and 2021 US Olympic Trials, Grayson moved to Mission Viejo with the sole focus of training for the 2024 trials in the hopes of making his Olympic berth for Team USA.

# **SEAN GRIESHOP**

Sean Grieshop, a professional American swimmer, has been competing at top levels in the sport of swimming since early in his career. In high school, he won World Juniors and broke World Junior records in the 400 IM and as part of the 4x200 Free relay. He attended Cal Berkeley and was part of 3 National Championship teams, numerous All-American titles, and internationally earning a silver and bronze at the World University Games in 2019. Sean joined the Nadadores as a professional at the beginning of the 2023-2024 swim year and kicked off his Nadador



career with multiple top 8 finishes in the 400 IM at the World Aquatics 2023 World Cup circuit.

"I am very excited to represent the Mission Viejo Nadadores, my family and myself in the upcoming Olympic Trials. With this being my third OT's I am looking forward to competing against the nation's fastest swimmers to try to achieve my goals. I want to thank my parents, friends and anyone who has been a part of my journey in this sport. Go Nadadores!"

### **JAN LEVINRAD GETS GOLD!**

From November 3 - 11, Jan Levinrad participated in the 11th International Gay and Lesbian Aquatic Games in Guadalajara, Mexico. Jan brought home 7 Gold Medals – in the 50 and 100m Freestyle; 50 and 100m Backstroke; 50m Butterfly; 4x50m Mixed Freestyle Relay and 4x100m Mixed Medley Relay where she swam Butterfly. Jan set new Games records in 4 of her 5 individual events - the 50m Freestyle, 50m, and 100m Backstroke and 50m Butterfly.

This was Jan's 7th time swimming in the games in 5 different countries. In all of her competitions, she has won a grand total of 57 medals – 48 Gold; 7 Silver, and 2 Bronze. Jan is the highest female medal winner for the Games. Her relay team for the 4x100 Mixed Medley Relay has been swimming together for 30 years.

Jan wanted to acknowledge the volunteers who worked tirelessly to make the opening ceremony, the awards ceremony, and the entire Games an amazing experience. She's looking forward to the 2026 Games in Valencia, Spain,
