MAC EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

Nadadores staff have completed training for the management of emergency situations.

Our plan covers natural disasters (winds, smoke, earthquakes) man-made disasters (chemical, fire etc.) and breach of security (intruders, wild animals, hostage situations, etc.) Athlete groups will be trained again in October.

So parents are aware of the protocols:

- Airhorns and fire alarms will sound at the facility.
- Athletes will be quickly removed from the facility (different pathways depending on location of entry or emergency type).
- An emergency text message using TU will be sent to parents.
- Reunion locations will be either the YMCA parking lot or the Oso Creek Golf Course parking lot.
- Parents should NOT try to access the MAC parking lot during an emergency.

Staff has also been trained in the use of Narcan, which is available in emergency kits in dive, swim, swim school and the MVProShop.

OVERCOMING IMPORTANT SOCIAL CHALLENGES

The Mission Viejo Nadadores are committed to coaching and helping your athlete succeed and stay safe while a participant in the Swim and Dive Program. Therefore, we have secured online courses that will assist your athlete in overcoming some of today's most important social challenges facing teenagers. In order to ensure that these issues are being addressed here at the club, we are taking the proactive approach of requiring all Nadadores (swim and dive) who are 14 or older (or soon to be 14) to take these online courses.

Through the Mission Viejo Nadadores' Learning Portal, the following required courses are necessary for an athlete to participate in training with the Nadadores program. The titles of the modules (approximately 30 mins each) are: (1) Recognizing and Preventing Bullying, (2) Preventing Cyber Bullying, and (3) Dangers of Sexting, (4) Steroid, Drug and Alcohol Awareness - For Training Participants, and (5) Personal Conduct for Training - Participants.

All athletes must complete the five modules by October 31, 2023, to remain eligible to train with the Nadadores. As they complete the modules, our administrator will be sent a report with your child's name.

It is the sincere hope of the Foundation Board members and the coaching staff that this program helps us strengthen our children and gives them another tool to traverse the challenges of the teenage years.
